

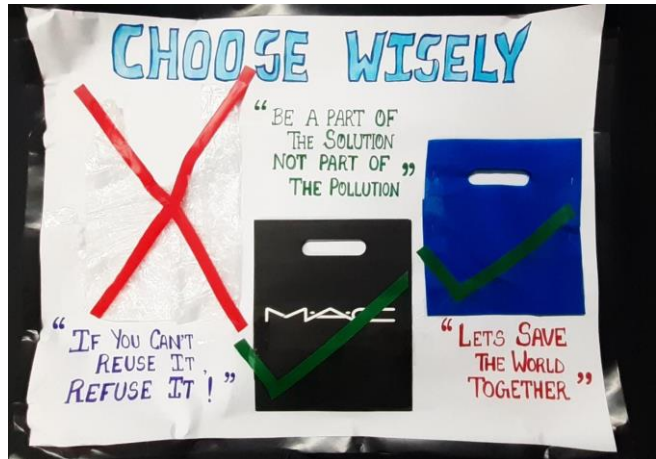

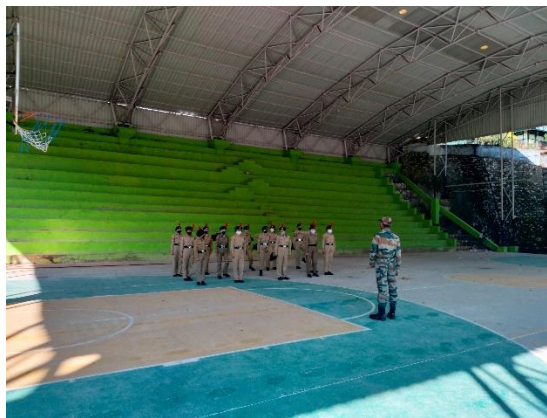
12. Inter Unit Shooting Competition
