With all these objectives in mind the Zoology department every year hold the departmental seminar for the final semester students with the collaborative participation of the lower semester students as well.

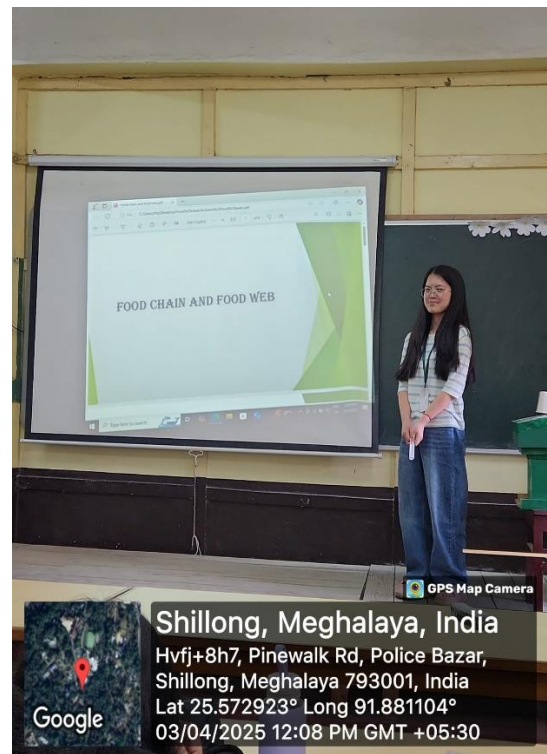

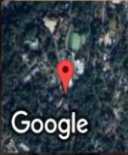
**Outcome:**

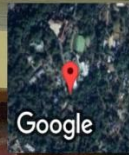
Seminars and discussions are excellent platforms not only to learn new aspects, other perspectives and latest information, but also a good way of networking.
