Fashion Designing Course (Career Oriented Course)

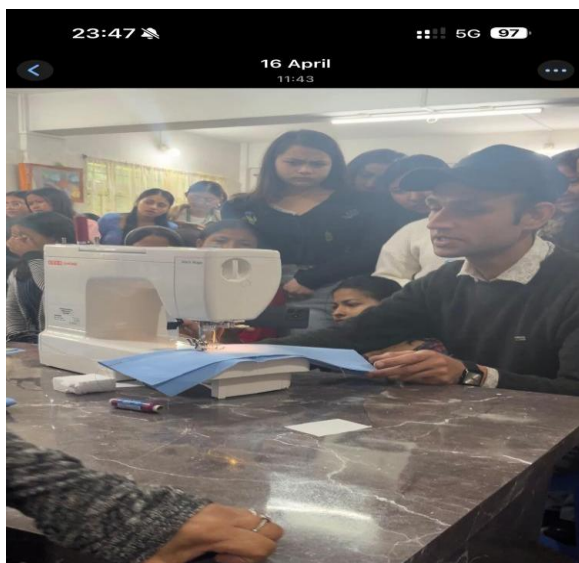
The Fashion Designing Course has achieved consistent growth over the years. In the academic year 2024-25, the Certificate Course of Fashion Designing Course, had a total enrolment of 183 students while the enrolment in the Diploma Course was 117 students during the same year. As part of the curriculum and in order to provide training and exposure to the Diploma course students are to pursue internship with renowned designers, boutiques or garment production unit. In the year 2024-25, Ten (10) students joined Faron Leather at Laitumkhrah Shillong and Four of them pursued in Chipper Design Studio at Mawlai- Mawtawar, Shillong from the 18th of September to the 18th of October 2024. Another batch of Fourteen (14) students joined Chipper Design Studio for their internship with effect from the 10th of March to the 10th of April 2025. From the 10th of June to the 10th of July 2025 another group of 12 (Twelve) students joined Mawrie garments for their internship.

In order to enhance students' learning experience outside classroom, on completion students of Diploma course are taken for a study tour. During the academic year 2024-25, Sixty (60) students were taken to Mawrie Garments, Rynjah Shillong on the 9th of August 2024. The students got to explore the garment factor, observe the working of different pattern cutting machines, overlock machines, Double stitching machines, interlock machines, computerised flat machine for knitting Sweaters, T Shirt and Sweatshirts sewing machines and Knitted garments school uniforms knitting machines. This garment factory also has a small/ medium export enterprise which export products to different district, states and also to other countries.

The Fashion Designing Course organised an Exhibition cum sale during the 89th Foundation Day celebration of the college on the 25th of July 2025. The items displayed during the Fashion show were -i) Draping kids and ladies' garment, ii) Painting and embroider kids and ladies clothing, iii) Crochet and Knitting Sweaters and Shawls, accessorised with waste fabrics and original jewellery and v) Tie and Dye Indo- Western collection.



On the 16th of April 2025, one hundred (100) students attended the demonstration by USHA (Guwahati) in the fashion Designing classrooms where the staff of the company displayed and demonstrated two types of electrical sewing machines i.e., Stitch Magic Automatic Sewing Machine (57 stitches function) and the Allure Dlx Automatic Sewing Machines (21 stitches function).





The students also made gifts for the Chief Guest and guests of the Two Day National Seminar conducted by the IQAC of the College on “Indigenous Knowledge System” held on the 1st and 2nd of May 2025.



The students also showcased their works in the Fashion show during the College Week held from the 9th to the 13th of September 2024.



Besides the above activities, the students of fashion Designing Course have always lent a helping hand in preparing and decorating the auditorium for the various events held in the college displaying their creativity and skills.
