

Blood Donation camp in collaboration with NEIGRHIMS

The NSS Unit of Lady Keane College, in collaboration with NEIGRIHMS, organized a Blood Donation Camp on the 28th of March, 2025 at Lady Keane College premises from 10 am onwards.

The Blood Donation Camp commenced at 10 am Volunteers and staff members from both Lady Keane College and NEIGRIHMS were actively involved in managing the logistics and operations of the camp.

Donors were required to register their details including name, age, contact information. Each donor underwent a medical screening process conducted by qualified healthcare professionals to ensure their eligibility for blood donation and to guarantee the safety of both donors and recipients. Eligible donors proceeded to the blood donation area where trained phlebotomists collected blood following strict protocols and safety measures. After donating blood, donors were provided with refreshments and were encouraged to rest for a while to recover their strength. After Screening 32 out of 50 students who volunteered to donate blood were eligible to donate.

Objective: The objective of the camp is to encourage voluntary blood donation and raise awareness about the importance of donating blood to save lives.

Outcome: The Blood Donation Camp witnessed enthusiastic donors including students, faculty members, and staff from Lady Keane College. The collaborative efforts resulted in the collection of a substantial amount of blood units, which will significantly contribute to meeting the blood requirements of patients in need.
