The purpose of the trip was to provide exposure to rural life and to observe strawberry plantations in Syntung Village, located in the East Khasi Hills District, approximately 64 kilometers from Shillong.

The team comprised 50 students and 5 faculty members: F.A. Wahlang, Susan Lyngdoh, Kerdalari Dkhar, Bassilisa T Thangkiew, and J.S. Pyngrope. The group departed from the college at 9:00 AM, arrived at the destination by 12:00 Noon. After a brief period of rest, the team took a lunch break.

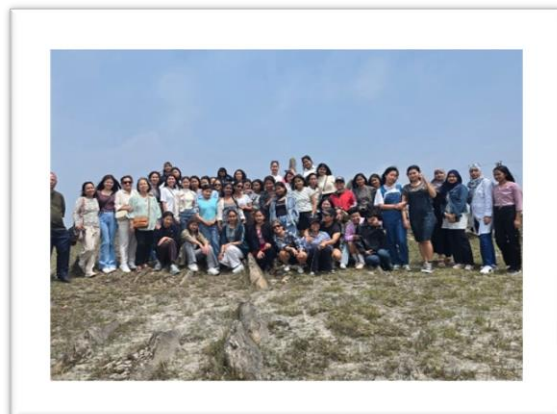
