

Field Trip Report
Kaziranga National Park
Dates: 8th and 9th March 2025

Introduction:

An exposure trip to Kaziranga National Park, Assam, was organized by the Department of Philosophy, Lady Keane College for two days (i.e., on the 8th and 9th of March 2025). A total of 17 students and 2 teachers participated in this educational and adventurous excursion. The primary aim of the trip was to observe the unique biodiversity of the region in their natural habitat and understand the importance of wildlife conservation and the concept of sustainable development.

Day 1: 8th March 2025

The group of students and teachers boarded the bus at the college premise and the journey to Kaziranga started around 7:30am in the morning and reached Nongpoh at 9:10am. We halted at Nongpoh for breakfast for 40 minutes and resumed our journey. We halted again at Jakhalabanda for lunch (from 12:15 noon to 1:15pm) and thereafter, continued our journey. We reached Kaziranga at around 3:00pm and check-in at the designated lodge.

In the evening, the students were briefed by the forest officials about the park's history, ecological significance, and safety protocols. Students learned about the park's diverse wildlife including the one-horned rhinoceros, elephants, wild water buffalo, swamp deer, and various bird species. The day concluded with a group discussion and reflection session around a bonfire.

Day 2: 9th March 2025

An early morning jeep safari was organized to tour the Central Range of the park. Students had the rare opportunity to witness animals in their natural habitat, including sightings of rhinoceroses, hog deer, wild boars, Bengal Tiger, wild elephant, wild buffalo and various migratory birds. The safari was guided by a trained forest guide who explained the behaviours and habitat of the animals. The trip concluded around 11:30am and we were dropped back at our lodge which was followed by a brunch.

The returned journey started around 1:15pm and reached college premise at around 8:30pm (with a brief halt at Nongpoh, around 5:45pm for a high tea) with enriching experiences and valuable insights into wildlife conservation and ecological balance.

Conclusion:

The field trip to Kaziranga National Park was both educational and memorable. It provided students with firsthand experience of wildlife, encouraged respect for nature, and deepened their understanding of the importance of biodiversity. The students were impressed by the community's efforts in promoting eco-tourism and conservation awareness.

This trip has also resulted in strengthening the bonding, care and respect between students (classmate) and teachers alike. The cooperation and enthusiasm shown by all students and teachers made the trip a grand success.
