**# International webinar organised on 26<sup>th</sup> September, 2022.**

An International webinar was jointly organised by the Mahatma Gandhi Center for conflict resolution and Peace studies in association with North East Institute of Social Science and Research (NEISSR), Dimapur, Nagaland on the theme 'Truth in Action: Karmayoga and Satyagraha, New Dimensions in Gandhian Pragmatics' on 26<sup>th</sup> September, 2022 from 6.00 p.m to 8.00 p.m.. The Keynote presenter on the occasion was Professor Ananta Kumar Giri, Professor, Madras Institute of Development Studies, Chennai. Another speaker who spoke on the revolutionary ideology was Dr. Janae Sholtz, Associate Professor, Alvernia University, Pennsylvania, USA. Professor Joe Campbell, Professor, Washington State University, USA, spoke on the theme Satyagraha as a means of revolution. Dr. Christian Bartolf, President, Gandhi Informatics Centre, Berlin, Germany, made an elaborate explanation on Mahatma Gandhi's way of life in the Sabarmati Ashram.

The book discussion that followed on a 2022 release of Anthem Press, New York, entitled 'Essays on Philosophy, Praxis and Culture' authored by Prof. Lou Marinoff, President of American Philosophy Practitioners' Association, three discussants took part. They included the author himself and Prof. Rick Repetti, Professor, The City College of New York, New York, USA and Professor Prasenjit Biswas, Professor, North-Eastern Hill University, Shillong, India.
