

CURRICULUM FOR SPOKEN HINDI

1. **OBJECTIVE OF THE COURSE:** Hindi being the National language of our country should be made more popular especially in the North-East as it can act as a bridge to communicate between people of this region and the rest of the country. This course will be helpful to both Hindi-speaking and non-Hindi speaking people.
2. **DURATION OF THE COURSE:** 3 months.
3. **TARGET GROUP:** Enrollment is open to anyone who has a 10+2 qualification. This course has been implemented specially for the students' development and knowledge in the Hindi language.

6. **EXPECTATIONS FOR STUDENTS:** 80% attendance and good behavior, regularity in Assignments and Tests.
7. **ASSESSMENT:** (a) 2 Internal Examinations – Written and Oral
(b) Grades will be awarded, for e.g. 80% and above = Grade 'A', 60% - 70% = Grade 'B', 40% - 59% = Grade 'C'.


