

## World Hearing Day Programme (28th March 2025)

To commemorate World Hearing Day, the National Programme for Prevention and Control of Deafness, National Health Mission, Government of Meghalaya organised a programme at Moreau Institute for Integral Training seeking to raise awareness on hearing health, preventive measures for hearing loss and the importance of early intervention. Teachers from a number of educational institutions and persons suffering from hearing impairment were invited to the programme. The main features were a keynote address made by Dr. B. Lyngdoh Joint Director of Health Services and a panel discussion featuring Shri. K. Prasad (MPS), Superintendent of Police (Traffic) East Khasi Hills, Dr. N.P. Laloo the Joint Director of Health Services, Dr S. Marbaniang an ENT Specialist, Dr. N. Wanswett a gynaecologist and Smt. J. Pyrboh an audiologist and Speech Therapist. This was followed by an interactive session.
